







- The Act seeks to
 - Regulate how waste will sustainably be managed
 - Create a framework for inter-governmental coordination and functional assignment between national and county governments
 - Set broad policy guidelines on waste management processes
 - Create a mechanism for private sector and citizen participation in sustainable waste management













Membership of Waste Management Council

- Chairperson appointed by the President
- Vice-chairperson Council of Governors nominee
- PSs in charge of waste management & Narional Treasury
- 1 representative of most representative private sector entity
- 1 representative of most representative manufacturing sector entity
- 2 professionals in waste management, 1 representing civil society

| Implications for private sector | Master management plan | Adoption of cleaner production processes |
